Child Care Options

Transitional Kdg. – 8th

All-Inclusive Plan - Discounted Rate: \$2,400 / \$240 per month (10 month plan) / \$218 per month (11 month plan)
Regular Rate \$2,472 / \$247 per month (10 month plan) / \$225 per month (11 month plan). This plan covers 6:30 AM to 6:00 PM including holidays during the school year when child care is open. (For eligible holidays see yearly calendar located on our website).

Full Day Plan - Discounted Rate: \$2,150 / \$215 per month (10 month plan) / \$196 per month (11 month plan)
Regular Rate \$2,215 / \$222 per month (10 month plan) / \$202 per month (11 month plan). This plan covers 6:30 AM to 6:00 PM, regularly scheduled school days ONLY.

AM Only Plan - Discounted Rate \$1,300 / \$130 per month (10 month plan) / \$118 per month (11 month plan)
Regular Rate \$1,339 / \$134 per month (10 month plan) / \$122 per month (11 month plan). This plan covers from 6:30 AM until school begins ONLY.

PM Only Plan - Discounted Rate \$1,730 / \$173 per month (10 month plan) / \$157 per month (11 month plan)
Regular Rate \$1,782 / \$178 per month (10 month plan) / \$162 per month (11 month plan). This plan covers from dismissal time until 6:00 PM ONLY, including half day dismissals.

- **All monthly payments** must be made by **auto debit on the 1st of the month (or the 15th of the previous month) or by auto credit card on the 1st of the month.**

Occasional Use Child Care - Families who are not on a pre-paid childcare program will be billed for the time their child is clocked in before or after school at \$2.75 per 15 minute increment. **Payment is due the 1st of each month** by check or on line payment through RenWeb PayNow. (Our policy allows a 30 minute grace period before school and 20 minutes grace after school without incurring occasional use charges.)

Half Day Dismissal – Families who are not on a pre-paid plan, but need afternoon childcare on half-days may RSVP on a pre-registration form for a discounted rate of \$25.00 for the entire afternoon. If not reserved, families will be charged \$2.75 per 15 minute increment (\$11.00 per hour) which will be billed to their account.

Holiday Rate – A pre-registration form will be provided with a discounted rate of \$45.00 per day (for those not enrolled in the All-Inclusive Plan). Any forms turned in after the due date will be charged \$50.00 per day. Payment is due with registration forms.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Does my child need to be tested?

All new students will be tested to determine appropriate grade level. New students must submit copies of their last report card and most recent achievement test scores to the office within one week of submitting their online application. Testing is by appointment only and will be arranged by the Admissions Coordinator. Families will be notified of their admission status within a few weeks of their entrance testing. Students accepted into FCS will be invited to complete their online enrollment.

Are there additional fees other than tuition that will be required?

One of the nice things about our tuition is that it covers the cost of all required programs. There are no extra costs for field trips, yearbooks, Science camps, course materials, iPads, computer lab and technology fees. It's all included!

How do I pay my tuition?

Families can pay tuition on an annual, trimester or monthly basis. All monthly payments must be made by auto debit on the 1st of the month (or the 15th of the previous month) or by auto credit card on the 1st of the month. A late charge of \$35.00 per month will be assessed on the unpaid balance of an account.

Is there a discount if I pay the entire yearly tuition in advance?

No discount will be given for annual tuition paid in full.

Are there discounts for additional children?

Tuition rates are set on a per pupil cost, so there are no discounts for siblings who attend the school or preschool.

What is the policy regarding checks and auto debits returned for non-sufficient funds (NSF)?

There is a **\$50.00** fee on all NSF checks and auto debit/credit returns. When an account is 5 weeks delinquent, a parent will be requested to withdraw their child from school. Statements are not mailed to parents unless there is a past due amount owed on the account.

If it is necessary to withdraw my child from school is the tuition pro-rated?

Children are considered enrolled by contract for the entire year. If a student withdraws for any reason, the **charges are pro-rated on a trimester basis**. The school will not require payment for the entire year, but families must pay for the entire trimester in which the child has attended. No deductions will be made for tuition or childcare absences during the school year, regardless of the cause of such absence. All withdrawals, whether before the school year begins or during the year, must be made **in writing** and shall be effective when such notice is delivered to the school. Any unpaid balance over 35 days may be subject to collections.

Are there tuition reductions for vacations and holidays?

Tuition and childcare are calculated on the basis of the entire school year; no reductions can be made for vacations or holidays.

How early can I drop my child off and/or how late can I pick my child up without incurring a fee?

Families have a *thirty minute* grace period before school begins and a *twenty minute* grace period after dismissal to drop off/pick up their child without incurring child care fees.

If I enroll my child in the prepaid child care program, can changes be made?

If you need to change your child's pre-selected childcare plan or withdraw from the child care program, the rate will be pro-rated on a trimester basis according to the plan selected and time used. There is no charge for the first change in a childcare plan. Additional changes will incur a \$20.00 service charge.

If we only need child care occasionally how do we pay?

Families who are not on a pre-paid child care program will be billed for the time their child is clocked in before or after school. (Our policy allows a 30 minute grace period before school and 20 minutes grace after school without incurring occasional use charges.) The "Time Clock" system will bill your account \$2.75 per 15 minute increment. Payment will be due on the 1st of each month by check or online payment through RenWeb PayNow – our online portal for parents.

Are volunteer hours mandatory for parents?

Volunteer service is not mandatory, but welcomed and encouraged.

Are we expected to participate in any fundraisers?

Fundraisers are necessary to help us improve our programs and accomplish our goals. We can't achieve everything on tuition alone. So, we have a few fundraising events at which we expect all families to participate.

The first is our annual fall gala at which we identify important school improvement projects to be funded. We ask every family to give a donation or monthly pledge to help us reach our goals. We don't dictate how much a family should give, but we expect every family to give something. The spring Jog-a-thon is another required fundraiser. Students get pledges from friends and family members and run an obstacle style course. We also encourage everyone to participate in our annual golf tournament held in the spring at various private country clubs.
