

# Junior High Distance Learning Standards

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## Expectations for Distance Learning

1. Be on time and prepared for the Zoom session.
2. Video must be turned on for the entire Zoom session. Students must be logging on with a device other than their personal cell phone.
3. Students may join Zoom sessions live with no background or they may use the school approved virtual background (to be provided).
4. Camera must be facing the student, not pointed at the ceiling or down at the desk, etc.
5. Students will establish a workspace in a quiet environment or use headphones. Must be sitting up at all times.
6. Student Zoom name must be First name Last name.
7. Students are not required to wear a school uniform to sessions but must be dressed in proper attire. (No tank tops, spaghetti straps, or inappropriate sayings/logos, etc.)
8. All assignments must be turned in on or before the due date set by each teacher.
9. Check your Google Classroom daily for assignments and due dates.

## How Often will We Zoom?

1. Each class will Zoom 2x per week for 90 minutes.
2. Teachers may provide optional times for tutoring/checking in.

## Parent Expectations

1. Carefully read all parent emails.
2. Reinforce distance learning standards and expectations for students
3. Check Renweb/Facts and Google Classroom weekly for assignments, due dates, and updated grades. (Renweb/Facts for grades; Google classroom for assignments)
4. Grades will be updated weekly for in class assignments and participation grades.
5. Check in with your child to monitor workload and help identify any missing work.
