## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### **How do I register for Foothill's Summer Program?**

**NEW THIS YEAR** - we are now hosting registration with an online software called Active. This is the same software that the City of Glendora Rec. Dept. uses for city summer activities. It will allow you to easily register multiple children at a time and come back at a later time to add more activities, if you choose.

### **Do I have to pay for all 11 weeks of the Adventure Camp or can I pay for only the weeks that I need?**

You have the flexibility to purchase only the weeks that you need. The camp weeks can be paid for up front or as you go. Additional weeks of camp must be registered for by the Wednesday prior to the week you want to attend.

### **What are the hours of Adventure Camp?**

We offer extended hours daily from 6:30am until 6:00pm.

### **I signed up for a week of camp that has a field trip but I do not want my child to attend the field trip. Can my child remain behind on campus?**

Field trips *for students entering 1st - 3rd grades* are optional, your child may remain behind at school with staff if they don't want to attend a field trip. However, field trips *for students entering 4th - 8th grades* are included in the weekly camp costs and there is

no stay-back option. If your child does not want to attend the field trip, you must make other arrangements for your child.

### **Do any of the summer programs offered overlap times with each other?**

Yes. We are excited to offer a variety of programs but some will overlap. When registering, pay close attention to the dates and times that your program selection is offered.

### **Is there a fee associated with canceling pre-purchased weeks?**

Yes, there is a small fee deducted from your refund if you must cancel a week you've already purchased.

### **How many weeks does the Bridge Academy academic program run?**

Bridge Academy will run for six weeks. *This is one more week than last year's program!*

### **I have two children not enrolled in summer camp, both attending Bridge Academy. My oldest and youngest have different class start times. Am I able to drop off both children at the earlier start time?**

Yes. Both siblings may be dropped off at the earlier class time together. Siblings will be allowed to stay on campus in a designated area while waiting to be picked up. Students enrolled in Adventure Camp will return to camp.

### **Will any portion of my summer camp week purchase be prorated if my child is unable to attend a day?**

Not at this time.

### **Is there a dress code for summer camp? What style of shoes is my child allowed to wear?**

Summer clothing is casual but must be neat and modest and should not contain any inappropriate writings, symbols, or markings. Comfortable, safe shoes with a back strap and covered toes at a minimum should be worn.

### **Is my child allowed to have a cell phone or other electronic device on their person while at camp?**

As a general rule cell phones are not necessary at school. If you need to get in touch with your child, please call the school office. If parents request for their child to bring a phone to school, it must be turned off and kept in the student's backpack. They may only use it with permission from a staff member. Personal video games and other internet connected devices should remain at home.

### **Can I order Hot Lunch for my child during summer camp?**
