E-Reader Policy

Following are basic guidelines for students who would like to use e-Readers for the Scholastic Reading Counts and other required books while at school.

- The family does not hold Foothill Christian School liable for any lost, damaged, or stolen eReaders brought to the school. It is strongly encouraged to label the eReaders with your name.
- Only eReader devices are allowed. No iPhones, iPads, iPods, and tablets are allowed. No Internet connectivity is allowed at any time. All devices must be on airplane mode. eReaders will only be used for reading books, no other application usage is permitted.
- Students 3rd -5th must give teachers their eReaders at the beginning of the school day. Teachers will store them in their designated areas in the classroom and will set a protocol as to when a student is allowed to use their eReader.
- Junior high students must keep eReaders in their lockers unless they have permission from their teacher to use it. eReaders will not be permitted outside during recess or lunch.
- If students are in childcare, they are allowed to use them per the permission of the childcare workers only in designated homework areas.
- Foothill Christian School has a one-strike policy. If a student does not abide by the FCS eReader policy, the privilege will be revoked.

Please sign and return this form to the office. Students will not be permitted to use eReader until submitted.
