Tuition Payments

Tuition is due on the 1st of every month and is late if paid after the 5th. A late charge of \$50.00 will be assessed on the unpaid balance of an account after the 5th of each month. Please note: You will receive a notice on Brightwheel 5 days before the 1st. For receipts, you can print your own through the app. Make sure your child's name is on all checks. If paying with a credit card a 2.9% charge will be added. If paying through your bank account, no extra fee will be applied. If you pay by cash, always come to the office, and wait for a receipt. If there are any changes to your child's schedule, or you need to withdraw, a two-week notice is required.
